Admissions Criteria

- Bachelor's degree with 2.5 GPA or higher
- Official transcripts of undergraduate and graduate coursework, including any teaching certificates/ licenses
- Statement of goals
- Two letters of recommendation
- Evidence of proficiency in English (if English is not your primary language, a TOEFL score of 79 or greater)
- **The GRE is not required**

ESOL Certificate holders are encouraged to apply. Please contact the program director for information about transferring previously earned credit to the M.Ed. in Languages program.
